

Foundation Center Directory Tutorial

Step 1: Go to The Foundation Center home page: <http://foundationcenter.org/>

Step 2: Click on the link for the Foundation Directory. It will take you to their page to a list of packages. Pick the basic package for \$49.99 a month. You can cancel this subscription at the end of the term if you do not want to keep it.

Some of you have expressed concerns about the \$50 fee to the Foundation Center Directory. The Foundation Center also has "holdings" [i.e. books with the same data in them] at various locations around the country in public libraries. The closest one to me is in Roanoke, VA. You can drive to one of them to complete the assignment. Their locations are listed on the Foundation Center website. <http://www.foundationcenter.org/collections/> I am also told that some United Ways have free public access.

Background

Established in 2003 in VA; converted from the sale of Southside Regional Medical Center.

The Cameron Foundation is a private foundation that promotes and provides support for programs and activities that benefit the residents of the Tri-Cities and surrounding area. This is the region that historically had been served by the hospital now known as Southside Regional Medical Center.

Limitations

Giving limited to VA, specifically to the cities of Petersburg, Colonial Heights and Hopewell; the counties of Dinwiddie, Prince George and Sussex; and the portion of the county of Chesterfield lying south of Route 10.

All the profiles must be attached as a PDF in gradebook. You are NOT permitted to re-type or “Cut and Paste” the information for this assignment. Do not put a link to the profile within your paper, it won’t work on the professor’s end. The profiles must be attached.

Step 7: Once you have found all your profiles create one Word document and list the profiles in rank order by belief of successful funding probability. Then briefly summarize your reasoning and explanation of the choices and rank order provided.

Step 8: Submit the profiles and word document in Blackboard using the assignment link. You can attach more than one document in Blackboard by clicking add additional attachment. If you have issues don’t wait until after the due date to email your professor. Email your professor with your issue along with your completed assignment as an attachment, before the due date. As always, read over the professors directions and rubric carefully to meet all assignment requirements.
